The application submitted by Our Lady College of Education, Chennai District together with the report of the Inspection Commission has been considered by the Syndicate on 08.10.2021 and passed orders to grant continuation of provisional affiliation to Our Lady College of Education to offer B.Ed and M.Ed degree programme for three academic years from 2021-2022 to 2023-2024 subject to the condition of retifying following deficiencies and submission of relavant required documents by the Management of the College of Education within six months.

- d. Name of Students admitted during the current session along with qualification, Percentage of marks in the qualifying examination and in the entrance test, if any, date of admission, etc.
- e. Fee charged from students.
- f. Available infrastructural facilities.
- g. Facilities added during the last quarter.
- h. Number of books in the library, journals subscribed to and additions, if any, in the last quarter.
- i. The affidavit with enclosure submitted along with application.
- j. The institution shall be free to post additional relevant information, if it so desires.
- k. Any false or incomplete information on website shall render the institution liable for withdrawal of recognition.

11. The institution shall adhere to the mandatory disclosure in the prescribed format and display up-to-date information on its official website.


12. The institution shall make available the list of students admitted on its official website.

13. The institution shall fill the information on GIS Portal on the NCTE Website.

If the institution contravenes any of the above conditions or the provision of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and orders made or issued there under, the institution will render itself vulnerable to adverse action including withdrawal of recognition by the Southern Regional Committee under the provision of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993.

Also order that a copy of this Order be published in the official Gazette.


