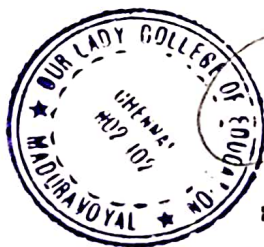

### Process

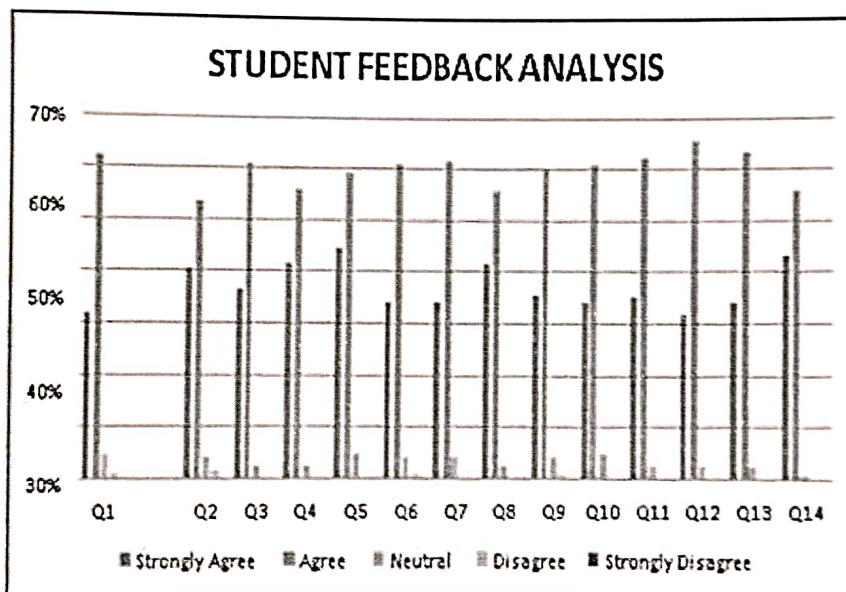


